



## Living With Wildlife Recommended Grades: K-2

### Program Summary:

Students are introduced to the word habitat and discuss the basic needs of plants and animals, how they differ and how they may be the same. Students will also learn that their very own backyard is a habitat for a surprising number of wildlife species including some they don't readily recognize as wildlife. Students will discuss and discover some important differences between wildlife and domesticated animals. While enjoying FEEECr's backyard, students will get to meet a domesticated rabbit and a native reptile.
