FIELD TRIP PRICING

A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required for all field trips to secure a field trip date. In the event of cancellation or inclement weather, deposits can be applied to a future field trip.

1 HOUR FIELD TRIP

\$8 per child or \$50 minimum

- First 4 chaperones (18+) and all teachers FREE, additional adults \$8 each

Select 1 topic

2.5 HOUR FIELD TRIP

\$10 per child or \$50 minimum

- First 4 chaperones (18+) and all teachers FREE, additional adults \$10 each

Select 2 topics (:45 hour each)

1-2 HOUR CUSTOM PROGRAM

Agreed upon program topic and non-refundable \$50 deposit must be submitted at least 1 month prior to the field trip date

\$100 minimum (exact price TBD based on number of students and cost of materials)

\$5 per child, \$50 minimum
